- Submission of quarterly activity report is compulsory and on non compliance for Consecutive quarterly reports will result in debarring of card and seizing of activity as per the decision of monitoring committee.
- In case of misuse/persistent complaints debarring of card and seizing of activity as per the decision of monitoring committee.
- Strictly useable for the given area only for Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation area.
- Form should be submitted in hard copy at Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation Head office, 3rd floor, Health Department.
- Application submitted once approved information will be send to Dist. SPCA and Resident Welfare Association.

Basic rules for Animal Care Givers

- Those who feed street animals are advised to participate in their sterilization and yearly vaccination's.
- Care givers are advised not to feed street animals away from their own residence, within 4km. radius of allotted location.
- Care givers are also advised to avoid feeding animals adjacent to areas in which children play or people walk or that are otherwise crowded (such as Parking, Entrance or lobbies).
- Feeding must not be done in a manner that contributes to littering or dirtying.
- Also care givers are advised to clean up feeding sites after feeding is over.
- Feeding should be done at a time with minimum human foot fall and also at fixed areas as possible.
- The feeding spots designation should be done in mutual agreement between feeders and Resident Welfare Association/Society members & nearby residents.
- The animals should be identified [collar, vaccination] by feeders & Resident Welfare Association.
- Care givers are advised to keep the sterilization and vaccination status of the Animals that they are feeding and caring also it should be updated and readily accessible.
- Apart from identified Animals no new should be encouraged in resident complex by any one.
- Compounds Animals are not property of one feeder, there is a different between pet and street/stray animals.
- In case of any stray animal attack identification of animal is must and followed by observation at for rabies by Animal Welfare Organization/Local Self Government for 10 days, As per Animal Birth Control Rules 2023 and to be release back at same location after 10 days.
